For this project, the existing 120,000 SF Central York Middle School facility, built in the 1950's, is rearranged programmatically, renovated and approximately 59,000 SF is added. The education design functions around the community concept and attempts to reuse existing portions of the building in new ways, primarily to accommodate the introduction of cutting edge technology and team teaching. Additionally, needs for family and consumer science training spaces, distance learning and graphic design facilities, music program expansions and social spaces are addressed.
